About Zipline

Zipline is a plugin-based news and information ticker for your desktop. Pulling events and information from Facebook, RSS feeds, iCal events and todos, Twitter and other sources, Zipline lets you passively keep an eye on what's going on on your computer and in your life. With its highly customizable interface, Zipline makes it simple for you to make it an integral and beautiful part of your desktop.

Added option to place Zipline above or below other windows
RSS items now use the favicon when possible

Installing Zipline

To install Zipline, simply drag it to your Applications folder or anywhere else you would like to keep it.

Getting Started

Following the instructions in the welcome window is a great way to begin using Zipline. If you want to get straight to the good stuff, mouse over the ticker, click Edit Sources, and choose which information sources you want Zipline to display. To use your Twitter or Facebook account, click the Options button for each and enter your username and password. While Zipline is running, it will scroll events and information across the top of your screen. To see more, mouse over the ticker and click an item. If Zipline has no new information to show, it will redisplay old items until new ones become available.
